Programme Aims

This programme invites Engineering, Science, and Business undergraduates from UCD's partner universities in China to explore academic and cultural life at an internationally recognised Englishmedium university. Through three main pillars—English for Professional Purposes, Design Thinking, and Discover Ireland & Europe—students gain skills essential to their fields while broadening their global perspectives.

Learning outcomes

- Engage in workshops that promote collaboration, creativity, and entrepreneurial thinking.
- Network with peers to exchange ideas on balancing life and study.
- Meet industry leaders across disciplines to gain real-world insights.
- Experience Ireland's unique heritage and learn about its place in a dynamic Europe.
- Access UCD's Belfield Campus facilities and connect with university staff.

Mode of delivery

Learning is activity- and enquiry-based within an international setting. Students work in small groups, benefiting from interactive breakout sessions. Programme goals are met through a presentation and portfolio, supported by expert course tutors. Time is also allocated to explore Dublin and Ireland's notable landmarks.

 - complete a short English learning portfolio based on your targets
 - receive a certificate of participation & performance from UCD
