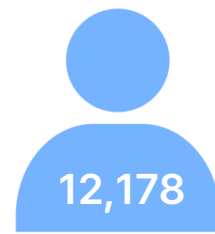

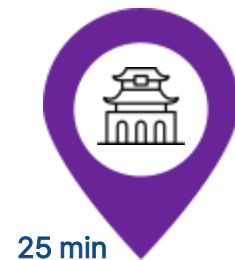

- Seoul Forest, SM's Kwangya, cafés, stylish boutiques, and pop-up stores and all things trendy – just around the corner.

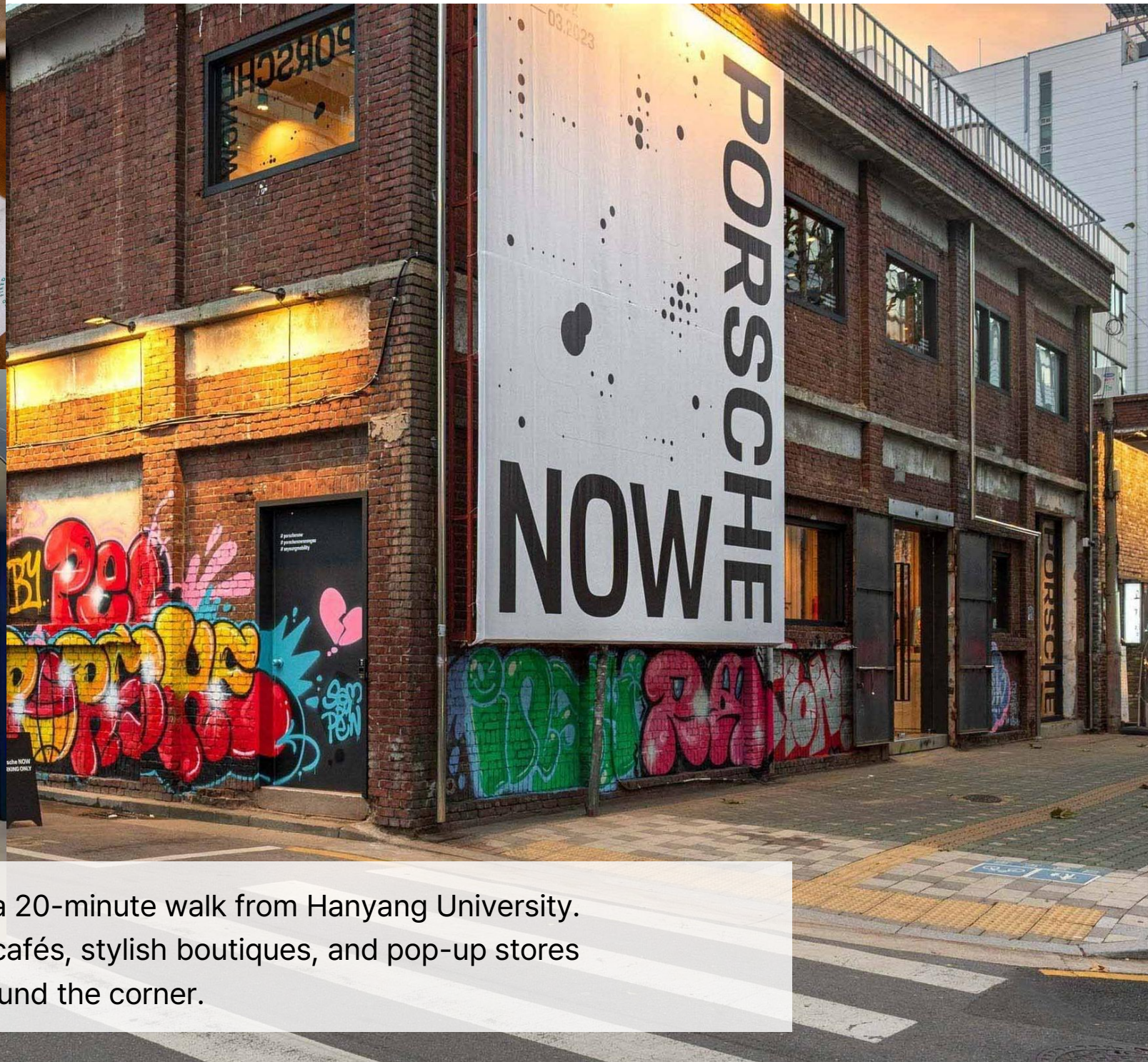
